The Driving Range is open will be operating under the following guidelines under further notice:

Opening Times

Arrival

- Upon arrival at the Golf Centre, please park alternately wherever possible
- Please proceed to the range via the reception end walkway and walk around the front balcony area (please do not enter the range at the range entrance, this is for exiting the range only)
- You will be met by a range attendant – please wait at the entrance by the clubhouse, you will be booked in and shown to your bay
- Please observe social distancing in the walkways and around the clubhouse

- Toilet facilities are available at the clubhouse end and regular cleaning will be undertaken during the course of the day.
- Please wash your hands as much as possible – there are also several hand sanitisers stations available

Member and Visitor Booking

Choose the Driving Range option

You can book via the website or by using your BRS App and choosing the Driving Range option

You can book one bay for a 30 minute session with 55 balls

Choose your time (this will relate to your bay number)

**More balls can be purchased on the day but must be used within the sessions and cannot be taken away with you. In the short term range cards can only be used to purchase additional balls on the day.

Practice Putting Area

The putting area is currently open to pre-booked golfers and range users only.

It is not open for the general public as a walk on service

The putting green is only available to those that have a pre-booked tee time or using the range.

The putting green is always limited to 6 players at any one time with players keeping a 2-metre distance.

The Academy Professionals will be conducting one-to-one sessions on the putting green, adhering to all the social distancing guidelines. Please make sure you keep to the other side of the green if they are teaching.

Health & Well Being

Please do not play golf or come to the Golf Centre if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19. The administering of first aid provision has been updated in light of the virus so we are limited in how much we can assist you in the event of accident/illness.
